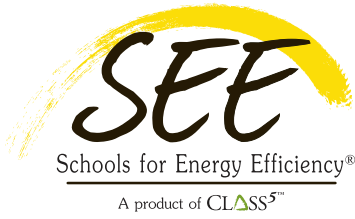


# SEE Program for Iowa Schools

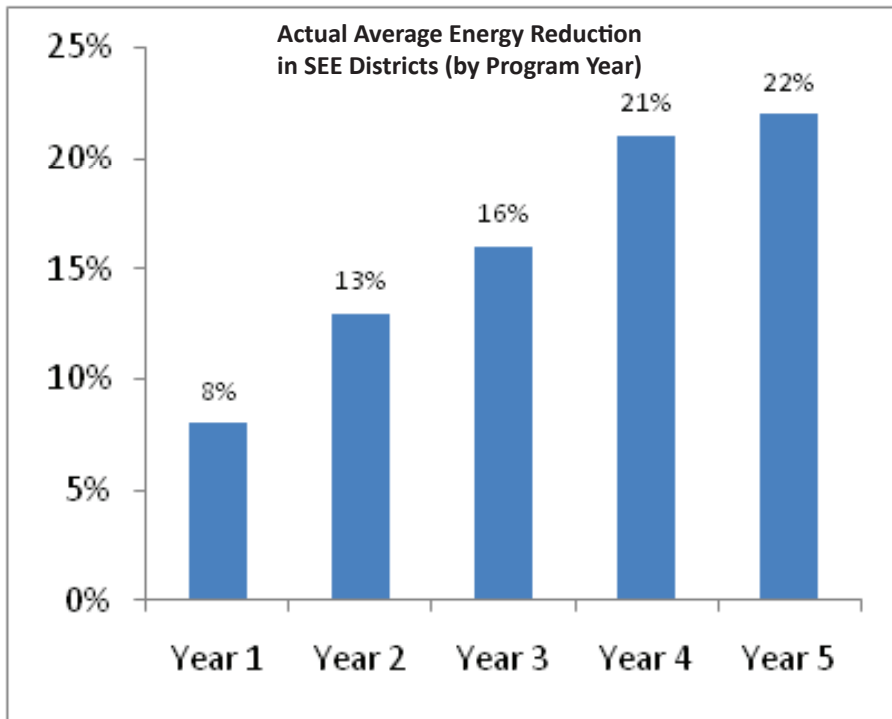
**Saving Money** – schools can use saved money where most needed.

## What is SEE?

SEE is a comprehensive five-year program designed by CLASS 5, Inc. to help K-12 schools reduce energy use and energy costs by changing behavior throughout the district. A proven program with over 700 school buildings (44 districts) enrolled to date, SEE provides schools with a systemized plan, educational energy awareness materials, training, and utility tracking for immediate and sustainable savings.

## SEE Goals for Schools

1. Reduce annual energy use by 10-percent or more.
2. Engage students, teachers, and staff through active participation.
3. Achieve national recognition for energy improvements through the U.S. EPA's ENERGY STAR® Program.
